



Artist In Residence Opportunity

Ochre Print Studio is the largest Open Access Fine Art printmaking studio in south east England and offers membership, internships, courses, workshops, exhibitions, talks and events.

The studio is located at Lockwood Centre in Guildford, within easy reach of the A3.

Managed by a core group of professional artists, this studio supports artists of all abilities including disability arts. There are excellent facilities for relief, screenprint, intaglio and textile processes, with associated groups and partners supporting and sustaining an artist's practice.

Responsibilities

Tuesday Open Access (one session weekly, either 10am to 2pm or 2pm to 6pm), responsible as technician during the session and for clear up of studio at end of session. Training and support will be given for this during the first month of the Residency

Help in coordination of Ochre Print Studio selected showcase exhibitions

Organise invigilation and help with preparation of Ochre's annual open exhibition

Help in promotion and promotional events for Ochre

Maintain a Blog of your professional development throughout your residency

Give a talk about your residency at our Christmas Party Thursday on 3rd December 2020

Mentor the incoming Artists in Residence 2021 for four to six weeks from January 2021
